The Collection is hosting a specially commissioned exhibition of Chinese contemporary art focusing on the significance in the Chinese imagination of Jiang Nan culture and the Yangtze River. On its journey from the mountains to the great delta, the Yangtze functions as a metaphor for constant change, as a channel between the open sea and the interior, and between tradition and modernity.

River Flows East seeks to explore how some of China's premier contemporary artists from the region are inheritors of Jiang Nan tradition and how they are responding to current globalised questions such as urbanization and industrialization of the countryside and the disappearance of the landscape.
